**WXLV 90.3 FM ANNOUNCES PROGRAM CHANGES;
LCCC STATION TO ADD MORE MUSIC**

Lehigh Carbon Community College (LCCC) and WDIY 88.1 FM announced today that the college's radio station, WXLV 90.3 FM, is making changes to its programming schedule starting Monday, July 14.

WXLV will offer its signature "Americana Roots" music all day, beginning at 6 a.m. WXLV is replacing its offering of National Public Radio (NPR) programming that it has provided through its management agreement with WDIY since March 2006.

"We are grateful for the support that WDIY provided in restructuring our radio station to better meet the needs of the college," said Ann Bieber, LCCC's Vice President for Strategic College and Workforce Initiatives.

"WXLV's programming evolution is another step in the station's growth to develop WXLV-produced programming that best suits the college demographic and others in the community who enjoy roots music," said Dr. Bill Dautremont-Smith, WDIY's interim executive director. "The move is consistent with their brand and will please many listeners seeking solid blocks of Americana music."

Currently, WXLV has 30 volunteers, including 12 LCCC students, all under the direction of XLV Program Director Burr Beard.

NPR's Morning Edition and All Things Considered will continue to be broadcast on WDIY, Lehigh Valley Community Public Radio on its main signal, 88.1 FM and its two translators, in Fogelsville, 93.7 FM and Easton, 93.9 FM.
